1. Who's gift was greater, the rich or the widow? Why?
2. Jesus tells his disciples in verse 17 everyone will hate you because of me. What promise of hope does Jesus give for this time?
3. What warning does Jesus give in verses 34-36? How can we apply this to our own lives?

## Luke 22

1. Who did Jesus say would be the greatest among his followers?
2. How does Jesus prayer on the Mount of Olives in verse 42 and his attitude in verses 47-53 show his obedience to God?
3. Why would Peter deny knowing Jesus even after the warning he was given that it would happen?

## Luke 23

1. Why did Pilate send Jesus to Herod? What do you think he was attempting to do or avoid?
2. How did the two thieves crucified on either side reactions to Jesus differ?
3. What can we infer about Jesus relationship to women from this chapter?

## Luke 24

1. At the end of Ch. 23, Jesus was buried by Joseph of Arimathea. A group of women followed Joseph to the tomb as he buried him. According to what happens in the beginning of Ch. 24, why was it significant that the women witness this event?
2. In verses 31-32, what impact did Jesus sharing Scripture have on the men on the road to Emmaus? What does this say to us about the power of God's Word?
3. What was the disciples response to the presence of Jesus?
